On-Field Player Code of Conduct

- We appreciate the commitment of players and their families to Dream Team. It is expected that players participate in all games. If it is not possible to make a game, parents should contact the coach prior to game.
- All players must arrive 30 minutes before game time for organizing and warm up purposes, unless previously communicated with coach.
- Players will remain in dugout or on field during games.
- Players, or a player partner for those with communication needs, will notify coaches if a player needs to leave bench or field for bathroom use, etc.
- If a player is dysregulated (yelling, crying, etc.) to the point that the game and/or fellow players are disrupted, they may be prompted to a cool down space until they are ready to play again. Parent may be asked to assist if necessary. We want all of our players on the field!
- As always, we welcome parents to watch and cheer, but please refrain from coming into dugout or onto field during game unless otherwise communicated with coaches.
- Players in the older division are expected to help clean dugouts after game, and see if younger teams need assistance, before leaving.
- Players may smile and have fun!
